We are committed to providing exceptional landscaping services. Please see below a short list of things to be aware of as residents of your community, to help achieve our standard of service.

Pet Waste – Please ensure pet waste is picked up. Lawn areas with pet waste may be skipped.

Lawn Areas - Please keep lawn areas free from toys and other obstacles. Solar lights and landscaping decorations should be placed at least 1 foot back in garden beds – not directly in the lawn - this will help avoid trimmer damage or staff tripping hazards. Items left in lawn areas are at residents' own risk. LBN is not responsible for any damage or replacements.

Estimated Service Schedule:

April/May/June - Spring cleanup & dethatching, weekly lawn cuts & garden maintenance, edge redefining on existing edges. 1st application lawn fertilization and weed control application.

July/August/September - Shrub/Hedge trimming begins (Timing of second round dependent on growth cycle), 2nd lawn fertilization and Weed Control Application

October/November - Leaf cleanup, garden preparation for fall, fall cleanups Winter setup.

Note: Services are scheduled with appropriate weather conditions and may fall outside of these intended dates. Standard service schedule shown above, package selected may not include all services

FAQ's:

Q: What day will my lawn be cut?

A: We operate on a regular weekly cut schedule and aim to remain consistent, weather permitting.

Cut days will be confirmed by late May after spring clean ups are completed.

Q: What about Weed Control?

A: We only use products that are approved for use by Health Canada. Our staff are full licensed and trained. We apply the minimum amount for effective weed management. Please refer to the schedule above and look out for signs posted before applications.

Q: What's included in Spring Clean Up and Gravel Sweep?

A: A thorough property cleanup, including lawn power raking and winter gravel removal from grass onto asphalt for collection. Note the gravel sweeping service is separate and will be scheduled and sign posted in advance
